The **B**rain **R**esearch through **A**dvancing **I**nnovative **N**eurotechnologies (BRAIN) Initiative is a multi-agency project aimed at revolutionizing our understanding of the human brain. The NIH version of the BRAIN Initiative began in April, 2013. Six program announcements were released in December 2013, and the awardees from those program announcements have just been announced.
